- 1) Various streets were identified to receive a seal coat (A1) surface treatment this FY to provide for much needed roadway maintenance and preservation. The areas are shown on the attached exhibit A.
 - 2) The above referenced project was advertised in the Illinois Dept. of Transportation (IDOT) Notice to Contractor's Bulletin 11-11 as well as the Rochelle Newsleader. Bids were publicly opened and read aloud on March 22nd, 2011 at 10 am for the above referenced project. Three separate bids were received as follows:
 - AC Pavement Striping Co. submitted a bid for making the entire improvements in the amount of \$229,571.44
 - Jim George & Sons, LLC submitted a bid for making the entire improvements in the amount of \$231,460.72
 - Road Oil, Inc. submitted a bid for making the entire improvements in the amount of \$238,571.35

Please refer to enclosure (2) for tabulation of bids as submitted by all bidders.

The various streets general maintenance project is being funded with Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds. The lowest bid is approximately 16% lower than the Municipal estimate of maintenance costs submitted to IDOT and approved on March 31, 2011. A transfer from FY 11/12 MFT fund 17-00 will be made to the FY 11/12 CIP fund 36-00-86091 to cover the Local Agency (LA) costs associated with the General Maintenance project of various streets Sec#11-00000-00-GM. Street Division crews will be patching with hot mix asphalt and sweeping in advance of the seal coat operations.

Furthermore, council approval of the resolution (BLR 14230) will allow the City to move forward with providing funding associated with engineering, maintenance and/or construction on the above referenced subject from the MFT fund. Enclosure (1) uses the standard IDOT resolution to document the requested expenditure.

Please consider acceptance of the low bid and award the contract to AC Pavement Striping Co. and reject all other bids received.
