Re: Municipal Code Revisions (Airport)

As Rochelle Municipal Airport continues to grow and expand changes to the Municipal Code Chapter 18 (Airport) may be necessary for certain types of commercial operations. The proposed changes reflect language to accommodate the most recent lease agreement with CSC and allow Airport staff the ability to “Hot Fuel” turbine powered aircraft as well as regulate other activities currently not allowed at RMA.

On April 14, 2011 the Airport Advisory Board met and discussed the proposed changes prepared by City Attorney Cooper and unanimously supported the amendments to Chapter 18. Fire Chief Brian Johnson has also reviewed the “Hot Fueling” procedures for both the City of Rochelle and Chicagoland Skydiving Center and has no objections to the changes.
