Re: Federal Aid Urban Route designations amendment

- (1) Resolution amending Resolution R09-23 authorizing the addition of Jack Dame Road, Intermodal Drive and Brush Grove Road to the Federal Highway System and change to a portion of 1st avenue

- 1) Staff has been working with IDOT programming to update Federal Aid routes and/or Municipal Streets for the official State/City of Rochelle 5 year functional classification map. In 2009 City council approved the addition of Jack Dame Rd, Intermodal Drive and Brush Grove Rd (as defined in R09-23) for addition to the Federal Highway System.
 - 2) Now that Jack Dame Road has been completed the route designation will need to be amended and updated as part of the functional classification map. The Federal Aid Routes designation will remain the same while the description limits will be modified to extend to Illinois Rte 38 (FAP 567). Furthermore, 1st Ave from the westerly end near 12th Street and extending approximately 0.37 miles to 7th Street (Rte 251) will become a local urban municipal street to be designated as MS route #3102. An amendment to resolution R09-23 must be passed by the local agency authorizing and requesting said changes to the routes, within its jurisdictional limits, to be added to the Federal Highway System.
 - 3) Please consider approval of enclosures (1) to authorize the amendment to resolution R09-23 to include the changes to the addition of Jack Dame Road, Intermodal Drive and Brush Grove Road to the Federal Highway System as well as the change to a portion of 1st Ave as described within the resolution all subject to the final approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation.
