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- 1) The above referenced project was advertised in the Rochelle Newsleader. Bids were publicly opened and read aloud on February 27, 2014 at 10 am for the above referenced project. Seven separate bids were received as follows:
  - Bruns Construction, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$264,169.32
  - AA Construction, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$296,460.53
  - Campos Construction, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$310,596.95
  - Elliott and Wood, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$329,009.90
  - R&R Contractors, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$359,891.95
  - M&M Concrete, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$377,551.00
  - Stenstrom Excavation and Blacktop Group, Inc. submitted a total base bid for entire improvements of \$415,711.75
  
- 2) The low bid, as received by Bruns Construction, Inc. was approximately 14% lower than estimated costs for the annual sidewalk maintenance project. The City will purchase the detectable warning plates for use on the sidewalk accessibility ramps. The 2014/15 City of Rochelle Sidewalk project is being funded through the Capital Improvements Fund No. 36-00-86500 Sidewalk/Pedestrian paths - Annual Program. A portion of this project will extend from the Safe Routes To Schools project completed in 2008 along 10<sup>th</sup> Ave, from 9<sup>th</sup> St to 16<sup>th</sup> St, near Tilton and St Paul Schools.

Should council approve the project then a Notice of Award and agreement will be issued to the contractor. The NOA and agreement will be subject to the contract documents and information to be submitted by the contractor including, but not limited to, the performance surety and certificates of insurance.

- 3) Please consider acceptance of the low bid as received and award of the 2014/15 City of Rochelle Sidewalk Project contract to Bruns Construction, Inc. and reject all other bids received.
