RE: Hwy. 251 S Sewer Project

The 2014-15 Capital Budget for the Water Reclamation Division includes \$75,000 for a sewer extension on Hwy. 251S. The existing main is too shallow to handle the flow from the facilities in the area, so a new main will be installed from the Central Freight building, south to an existing manhole. Matt Hansen of Willett-Hofmann performed the design and permitting for the project. Subsequent to the required public notice, bids were opened on April 30, 2014. Three contractors provided bids, and Martin and Company is the apparent low bidder. The bids received were:

Daniel Loos of Willett Hofmann reviewed the bids and confirmed that Martin and Company of Oregon is the apparent low bidder. Martin has completed numerous projects for the City, and they have the expertise and manpower to successfully complete the project.

I recommend that the City Council accept the lowest responsible bid from Martin and Company for \$55,218.71
