- 1) In late June of 2015 the City Council approved a contract for certain improvements associated with the Traffic pedestrian signalization and sidewalks improvements at Lincoln Hwy and IL Rte. 38 with O'Brien Civil Works and William Charles Construction Co. In order to document the expenditure, and utilize allotted MFT funds for the expenses, the IDOT requires a resolution of appropriation of funds to be submitted by the City of Rochelle as the local agency (LA).
 - 2) The Resolutions for Improvements of by Municipality under the Illinois Highway Code, BLR 09111 (enclosure 1 and 2), documents the appropriation of funds for the projects by the City at this time. Said payments will be disbursed from CIP fund #36-00-86096 IL Rte. 38/ Lincoln Hwy signals pedestrian crossing. Some or all of the project expenses will be paid for through the City's MFT fund.
