
Rochelle City Council Members:

Proposed Plan

As previously and successfully done, we request to close the East and West ends of Cherry Avenue, Saturday, June 23, 2018. The purpose of this temporary closing is to offer free entertainment, outdoor activities and fund raising for the Rochelle Fire Department which will be set on Cherry Avenue, from the Eastern End at Main Street to the Western End at Lincoln. This will provide a repeated attraction for the city of Rochelle.

Benefits:

- Repeating this event will advance camaraderie among the businesses on Cherry Avenue, as well as provide an attraction for residents both locally and in neighboring communities.
- This will create an opportunity for increased revenue for businesses located in downtown Rochelle, as proven by neighboring communities who have held similar events.
- Allowing this event to be repeated will create an expectation of continued events within the downtown region, providing the opportunity to promote Rochelle as the premium destination we all desire to do.
- This will allow us exposure of the advancements made within the downtown area, as well as Cherry Avenue, and will showcase the many changes Rochelle has recently made.
- Local entertainment will be utilized.
- Local media advertisements and participation will begin weeks prior to the event, once approved. In addition, 102.3 will be hosting a live broadcast from inside Kenny's Place the day of the event, increasing awareness as well as promoting the charitable portion for The Rochelle Fire Department Fund. City Requirements

- Closing of Cherry Avenue, beginning at 6:30pm to permit set up for entertainment, continuing until 12am for tear down

City Requirements, cont'd.

- **Providing barricades at the East and West ends of Cherry Avenue, from Lincoln Avenue to Main Street**
- **Permitting the event to begin at 8pm, with entertainment beginning at 8pm and concluding at 11pm. This will allow us to have Bag Game playing, fund raising for the Rochelle Fire Department as well as fellowship among attendees.**
- **Electrical connections to various street lights along Cherry Avenue for set lighting to provide a safer environment**
- **Parking restrictions along Cherry Avenue, to begin at 6pm**

Precautionary Measures (provided by Kenny's Place)

- **Staffed Security that will be posted at either end of Cherry Avenue, ensuring minors are not permitted to enter, as well as throughout the event, ensuring a safe environment throughout**
- **Ample waste receptacles and tobacco retainers provided to eliminate littering**
- **Tables and Chairs**
- **Stand Lighting to ensure a safer environment**
- **Sale of only aluminum and plastic container beverages to reduce the potential of broken glass along Cherry Avenue**
- **Band will conclude at 11:00pm, as defined in the City Ordinance for noise control**
- **Entire area will be thoroughly cleaned following the event, guaranteeing our city streets and sidewalks on Cherry Avenue remain pristine.**

Affected Parties and Businesses

- **While businesses will not be prohibited in anyway by barricade, Kenny's Place will be funding the entire event in celebration of our first year anniversary. We encourage customers from all outlets to participate in this event, and will coordinate with other businesses to ensure they are welcome.**
- **Parking restrictions along Cherry Avenue will need to be enforced, beginning at 5pm, allowing the area to be free from vehicles.**
