Line up will begin at 5:30 with the parade scheduled to start at 6:00 p.m. The Chamber is requesting assistance in redirecting traffic associated with the line up and parade and Chief Buck has no objections to their request. As there were no objections from the Council, management will approve the request
- **Downtown Rochelle Association Request** The City has received a request from Diane Gittleson on behalf of the Downtown Rochelle Association. This request relates to the use of downtown streets for horse rides associated with the Christmas Parade and Christmas Walk on December 7, 2007. These horse drawn rides are free and the route for the horse rides will be the same as in past years. As there were no objections from the Council, management will approve the request
