**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION R09-23
AUTHORIZING ADDITION OF JACK DAME ROAD, INTERMODAL DRIVE AND
BRUSH GROVE ROAD TO THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND CHANGE A
PORTION OF 1ST AVENUE TO A MUNICIPAL STREET DESIGNATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public and there are demands for certain changes to be made to the Federal Highway system in the City of Rochelle; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Federal Highway System be compatible with the needs of the traveling public in the City of Rochelle

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rochelle that the Illinois Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration be requested to approve the following locations for an (urban or rural) minor arterial route for the City of Rochelle's Federal Highway system as follows:

Intermodal Drive, from Illinois Route 251 (FAS 1177), westerly to the intersection of Jack Dame Road and Intermodal Drive. Thence westerly, along Intermodal Drive, to Brush Grove Road located along the West line of Section 34, T.40N. R.1.E. Thence southerly, along Brush Grove Road, approximately 1400 feet to the existing corporate limit line of the City of Rochelle. Said corporate limits being located approximately 300' north of the Kyte River. The aforementioned described Route shall be assigned FAU 5470.

Jack Dame Road, from Intermodal Drive, northerly to the current local road known as 1st Avenue (FAU 5447) for approximately 4900 feet (0.93 miles) thence westerly for approximately 850 feet to Illinois Route 38 (FAP 567). The aforementioned described Route shall be assigned FAU 5471.

1st Avenue, from the westerly dead end near 12th Street and extending easterly approximately 0.37 miles to 7th Street (Ill. Rte 251 overpass), will be designated as a local urban Municipal Street to be assigned Municipal Street No. 3102.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be, and is hereby authorized to and directed to transmit six certified copies of this resolution to the Illinois Department of Transportation through the Deputy Director of Highways Region Two Engineer's Office at Dixon, Illinois.
