Re: Fiber Optic Access Rates

Dear Mr. Plyman;

In June of 2011 RMU communications changed internet service providers. The switch from Qwest Communications to ISI Communication in Dupage, IL resulted in a savings of \$58,000.00 per year on our internet access charges. Along with the savings, our bandwidth speeds increased from 45 Mb to 100 Mb.

At the July 27, 2011 Utility Advisory Board meeting, I presented a revised cost structure, passing savings on to our fiber internet access customers. Currently RMU offers 7 different fiber internet access packages. Recently, we have cut these options down to four, still offering a full range of services from 3 Mb up to 10 Mb download speeds to our customers. Attached are the new rates that the UAB unanimously approved. It is my recommendation that City Council also approves these new rates for immediate use.
