Re: Airport Sanitary Sewer Bids

Sealed bids for construction of a sanitary sewer system to service the Rochelle Municipal Airport and associated businesses were opened on August 25, 2011. Two bids were received for consideration, Civil Construction (\$289,672.00) and Northern Illinois Service Co (\$306,475.20). Both bids are above the budgeted amount allocated in the 2011/12 fiscal year Airport fund. After review of the bids with Dave Plyman, Kathy Cooper, and Noah Carmichael (Fehr-Graham) it was determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to make design modifications and re-bid the project in an attempt to reduce associated construction and equipment costs while still providing the necessary sanitary sewer service.

Please consider rejecting all bids so we can proceed with re-bidding this project and continue to move forward with our commitment to provide sanitary sewer to Rochelle Municipal Airport.
