Re: Airport Sanitary Sewer

Sealed bids for construction of a sanitary sewer system to service the Rochelle Municipal Airport and associated businesses were opened on October 20, 2011. Design modifications were made and the project re-bid in an effort to reduce construction costs while still meeting our obligation to have sewer in place by April 1, 2012. Bids have been reviewed by our consultant Fehr-Graham & Associates with a recommendation to accept the low bid from Stenstrom Excavation and Blacktop Group, Rockford Illinois for a total of \$179,409.50.

Fiscal year 2011/12 Airport Capital Outlay included \$150,000 for this project. The amount budgeted for this project was submitted based on what I knew at budget time and before obligations were made to extend the service to the Sky Team Inc. leased property line which increased the overall project cost. Other capital outlay projects such as a new airport entrance sign will be delayed this year with funds allocated for that projects used for the sanitary sewer to make up the difference of the amount budgeted, also two other completed projects, taxiway improvements and well improvements both were completed under the budgeted amount and will allow the necessary funding to proceed.

My recommendation is to accept the low bid in the amount of \$179,409.50 from Stenstrom Excavation and Blacktop Group for Rochelle Municipal Airport Sanitary Sewer Improvements.
