As Coordinator of the Lighted Christmas Parade, I would like to respectfully request permission of the City Council to hold the Annual Lighted Christmas parade on Friday, December 7th, 2012 with 5:30 step off. The parade will be held in conjunction with the Old Fashioned Christmas weekend.

The parade route will begin on North Main (Near Fire Station) with the registration to be in front of the fire station. The parade will proceed North on North Main near the fire station, to 7th Ave., West on 7th Ave. to Lincoln Hwy., South on Lincoln Hwy to Lincoln Ave., West on Lincoln Ave. to 6th Street, then North on 6th street ending at City Hall for the Lighting of the Christmas Tree and the presentation of the Rochelle Community Gratitude Award. The Christmas tree lighting is to be done by Santa. Line up will begin at 5:00 p.m. with the parade kicking off at 5:30 p.m. The approximate time for the parade will be 30 – 45 minutes.

We are requesting the need for traffic control as the parade enters Lincoln Hwy. at approx. 5:40 pm. A squad could then follow the parade through to City Hall. I would also like to have a squad in the parade behind the VFW Color Guard if possible.
