Re: Compliance Commitment Agreement
Violation Notice: W-2016-00015

Well 11, located at the High School on Flagg rd. has been recently issued a notice of violation by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) for radium exceeding the maximum contaminant levels (MCL). According to state statute, RMU is required to respond in writing to the IEPA outlining what actions we will take to return the well back into compliance. Also, we must state whether we are willing to enter into a compliance commitment agreement (CCA) with the state.

Through a series of conversations with the IEPA, they agreed to resolve this with 1 of 2 options. Move forward with the planning and design of a radium removal plant at well 11 and continue quarterly sampling and testing for radium over the next year. If we are able to lower our annual running average for radium below the MCL in 4 consecutive quarters then we will be in compliance and have no reason to proceed with the construction of a treatment plant. If the continued sampling does not yield results below the MCL, construct the treatment plant as outlined in the CCA at an approximate cost of \$2-3 million. If we construct a treatment plant, it would not be operational until February 2018.

The IEPA agreed to these provisions and is spelled out in the attached CCA. I recommend entering in to this agreement as these are the best options available at this time.
