ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-46 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
CITY OF ROCHELLE TO DELETE ONE RESTAURANT/RECREATION LIQUOR
LICENSE

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, a Restaurant/Recreation license previously issued to Big Dan's Switch Yard Grill & Bar, Inc. d/b/a Switch Yard surrendered their license; and,

WHEREAS, in light of the closing of liquor license of this business, the City Council deems it appropriate to reduce the number of Restaurant/Recreation licenses allowed by the Rochelle Municipal Code from nine (9) to eight (8); and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHELLE, OGLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that Section 6-46 of the Municipal Code of the City of Rochelle be amended to read as follows:

“6-46 License-Number Limitations. There shall be issued in the city not more than six tavern licenses, not more than two restaurant licenses, not more than eight restaurant/recreation licenses, not more than three package licenses, not more than four package beer and wine licenses, not more than two restaurant beer and wine licenses, not more than two club licenses, and not more than six one-day nonprofit beer and wine licensee, per year. Not more than one one-day nonprofit beer and wine license shall be issued for the same date.”

This ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law and shall modify any inconsistent provisions in the municipal code prior to this date.
