A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 17-08 DIRECTING ALL STREET LIGHTING COSTS TO BE ASSUMED BY ROCHELLE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES (RMU) AND REMOVED AS AN EXPENSE OF THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 511-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City provides utility services including electric, water, sewer, wastewater treatment, and advanced communications to the greater Rochelle community through the Utility Department, which is commonly referred to as Rochelle Municipal Utilities (RMU); and

WHEREAS, the RMU currently bills the general fund of the City of Rochelle for the cost of energy associated with the operation of street lighting within the City; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2017, the City of Rochelle passed Resolution 17-08 regarding the billing of the general fund for the cost of energy associated with the operation of street lighting within the City; and

WHEREAS, none of the billing protocols set forth in Resolution 17-08 have been instituted; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City, the RMU, and its residents to rescind Resolution 17-08; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rochelle as follows:

1. That the recitals set forth above are adopted and incorporated herein.
2. The Mayor and City Council Manager rescind Resolution 17-08 approved on September 25, 2017.
