AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND UPDATING CHAPTER 6 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF ROCHELLE TO MODIFY THE LICENSE CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM, LICENSEE FEES, AND OTHER PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, provides in part that in every city the city council “shall have the power by general ordinance or resolution to determine the number, kind and classification of licenses, for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor not inconsistent with this Act and the amount of the local licensee fees to be paid for the various kinds of licenses to be issued”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has not reviewed or updated the city’s license classification system, licensee fees, or performed a general review of Chapter 6 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Rochelle Municipal Code in many years; and

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner has made certain recommendations to the City Council to amend the license classification system, licensee fees, and other provisions to update Chapter 6 of the Rochelle Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is in the best interest of the residents, businesses, and institutions for the City to periodically review and update Chapter 6 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Rochelle Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to amend Chapter 6 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Rochelle Municipal Code to modify and update the license classification system, licensee fees, and other provisions; and

WHEREAS, all other necessary findings have been made;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCHELLE, OGLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. Chapter 6 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Municipal Code of the City of Rochelle is hereby amended to read as shown in **Exhibit A** attached hereto (additions shown in red underline, deletions in red strike-through).

This ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law and shall modify any inconsistent provisions in the municipal code prior to this date.
