

Rochelle Energy LLC Landfill Gas to Energy Facility

Rochelle Energy LLC is a renewable energy facility that utilizes landfill gas that would otherwise be combusted in a flare to instead produce up to 3.2 megawatts of electricity. This locally-oriented alternative energy source makes beneficial use of solid waste from the region to generate electricity that powers the region. The facility has been operating for 6 years and is designed to continue operation until the Landfill is closed and no longer producing gas.



Rochelle Energy LLC generates Renewable Energy Certificates for each megawatt of energy produced. These certificates are transferred directly to Rochelle Municipal Utilities, after which they can then be sold, bartered, or used to comply with a regulatory requirement.
