OGLE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the CITY OF ROCHELLE is subject to natural and man-made hazards including severe thunderstorms, severe winter storms, floods, tornadoes, and drought among others, that pose risks to public health and property; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF ROCHELLE desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural and man-made hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Ogle County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan was updated in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF ROCHELLE has participated in updating the Ogle County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of Ogle County:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the CITY OF ROCHELLE hereby:

1. Adopts the updated Ogle County Multi-Jurisdictional All Hazards Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of CITY OF ROCHELLE; and
2. Agrees to participate in the annual and 5-year updates to this updated Plan.
