

COVID-19 RELATED EMERGENCY ORDER 20-02
TEMPORARY SALE OF PACKAGED ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR
APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Governor Pritzker signed Executive Order in Response to COVID-19 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 5)¹ in which the Governor suspend business operations for restaurants, bars and food halls from March 16, 2020 through March 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the complete suspension of operations for restaurants, bars and food halls located in the City of Rochelle, Illinois has and will create a financial hardship for the owners, operators and employees of these business establishments; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Liquor Control Commission's "COVID-19 Related Action Guidance on Temporary Delivery of Alcoholic Liquor" dated March 19, 2020² has provided recommendations to ease the financial hardship of restaurants, bars, and food halls affected by COVID-19 Executive Order No. 5; and

WHEREAS, the restaurants, bars, and food halls are a vital part of the City of Rochelle's community and economy; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the Liquor Commissioner issued Emergency Order 20-01 regarding the temporary sale of package alcoholic liquor, permitting allow liquor licensees in the categories of Class B, C, and R liquor licenses to apply for an emergency package rider using the form attached hereto as Attachment 1, which would permit the sale of any and all alcoholic liquor in original package form for consumption off the premises; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Governor Pritzker signed Executive Order in Response to COVID-19 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 2020-18)³ in which the Governor suspend business operations for restaurants, bars and food halls from April 1, 2020 through April 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner, upon recommendation of the City Manager, and pursuant to the Illinois Liquor Control Commission's "COVID-19 Related Action Guidance on Temporary Delivery of Alcoholic Liquor" dated March 19, 2020, the Liquor Commissioner's powers set forth in Chapter 6 Article I, Section 6-15, and 235 ILCS 5/4-4, finds that is it necessary to issue a supplemental order as set forth below:

1. Recitals. That the Liquor Commissioner hereby incorporates all of the recitals above into this Order as if fully set forth herein.

2. Supplement to Covid-19 Related Emergency Order 20-01. The March 23, 2020 Covid-19 Related Emergency Order 20-01 is hereby extended in duration for ninety (90) days, or until the expiration of the Governor Pritzker's COVID-19 Executive Order No. 2020-18, or any extension thereof, whichever occurs first.

3. Full Force and Effect. Except as otherwise provided herein all other orders shall remain in full force and effect.

12. Governor's Authority. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to supersede the authority of the Governor and any orders that may be issued by the Governor related to the operation of businesses and/or the sale of alcoholic liquor in the State of Illinois.
