A RESOLUTION COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois provides that a municipality that is not a home rule unit shall only have the powers granted to them by law and as such the City of Rochelle, Ogle County, Illinois being a non-home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of said Section 7 of Article VII, and may exercise only the powers expressly granted by law; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly granted non-home rule municipalities broad authority to “pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities.” 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rochelle, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois competitive regional economic development grant application; and

WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant is essential to allow the City of Rochelle to undertake the project to construct an Electric Distribution Substation near Ritchie Road and Ritchie Court; and

WHEREAS, criteria for the Rebuild Illinois program are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Rochelle has certain monies budgeted and allocated for the construction of the Electric Distribution Substation with cash on hand, as required for the grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rochelle, Ogle County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The foregoing recitals shall be, and are hereby, incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth in this Section One.

SECTION TWO: That the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rochelle hereby commits the necessary funds from the Electrical Utility Capital Fund for use in conjunction with a Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant, such funds equal to 83% of the estimated total project cost of \$12,000,000 or \$10,000,000.

SECTION THREE: If any provision of this Resolution or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid

application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Resolution is severable.

SECTION FOUR: Where the conditions imposed by any provisions of this Resolution are more restrictive than comparable provisions imposed by Resolution in any other local law, ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation, the regulations of this Resolution will govern.

SECTION FIVE: The City Clerk shall publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION SIX: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
