**SUBJECT:** Ordinance Waiving the Competitive Bidding Requirements and Authorizing the City Manager to Enter into Agreement for the Purchase of a Sewer Jetter Truck

**Summary:** The new Environmental Protection Agency guidelines for the issuance of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit entails discharge limitations, monitoring, and reporting requirements. Under these guidelines we are required to implement a Capacity Management Operations and Maintenance (CMOM) program which includes a strategy to prevent discharges from sanitary sewer overflows or basement back-ups and ensuring that overflows or back-ups, when they do occur, do not cause or contribute to violations or cause impairment in any adjacent receiving water. As part of the process to achieve compliance, through the elimination of and mitigating the adverse impacts of any such overflows event, we must consistently jet and televise sewer lines.

The old, existing Vactor jetter truck will be shared by the Water, Streets and Electric departments to hydro excavate and to jet storm systems.
